

RESIDENTIAL PARKING PERMIT ZONE B & ZONE CC PARKING ENFORCEMENT

Parking Control Officers have begun enforcing the Monday through Friday 9:00am to 5:00pm 2-hour parking limit for vehicles parked in Residential Parking Permit (RPP) Zones B & CC on a daily basis.

Many vehicles over the past year have been parking in the area without the RPP Zone stickers, many out of area people parking and walking to BART, while others who live in the neighborhood have parked without a citation. It is imperative that residents be given the opportunity to park in their own neighborhood, as well as those who will be shopping at Hmart in the near future. Hmart's success depends on parking spaces not only in the OceanView Village parking lot, but also on the street, in and around the supermarket. They will be limited to 2 hours (M-F).

Residents are able to purchase a RPP Zone B* or Zone CC sticker, depending upon your address. Parking permits are valid for one year, and are renewable August 1st of each year. The current fee for a RPP Zone permit is \$144 annually. Residential parking permits may be obtained at 11 South Van Ness Avenue, near Market Street.

The following information is required to receive a RPP sticker:

- Current California motor vehicle registration. The registration must be in the applicant's name with the current permit address and vehicle license plate number.
- One additional proof of residency is required, such as a utility bill, current lease/rental agreement, proof of a home ownership, current vehicle insurance policy, or bank statement with current address.
